## Troop 1033 Receives Awards at Summer Camp

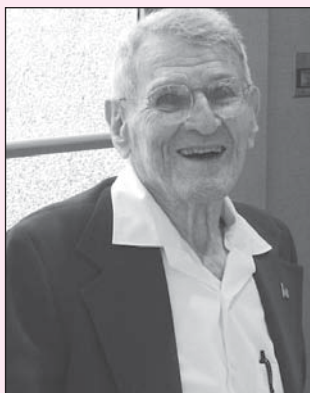

The Prince George's Summer Teen Theatre (PGSTT) had another successful summer this summer with Thoroughly Modern Millie. Having been a part of the Beltsville Community since 1967, PGSTT has always strived to provide an environment that allows teenagers to create a new world every summer. The program offers a chance for all teenagers to try their hand at working in many facets of theater.

This summer, the teenagers were asked to go back in time to the 1922 New York, a time very different from the present. It was a time when hair, clothing, pattern of speech, attitude, body language and many other facets of life were completely different from contemporary life. It allowed the teenagers involved to create a society that they were unfamiliar with, breaking them out of their comfort zone. The joy of Prince George's

Summer Teen Theatre comes in watching the creation of a new world year after year. Without the talent and imagination of the teens, there would be no PGSTT.

In times when local school systems are cutting arts budgets, community theatre is becoming a more important aspect of life in the area. PGSTT gives teens the creative outlet that they may not get at their schools. It also gives them a taste of working in a professional theatre environment.

PGSTT has been performing for 42 years. They are the longest running teen musical theatre organization in the United States. PGSTT is a not-for-profit youth organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors. Its mission is dedicated to providing Prince George's County and its surrounding communities with the opportunity to encourage and promote interest in all facets of theater arts through a summer program designed for the teen student.

This program provides instruction and knowledge in the various standards and skills of theatrical arts and productions, a vehicle for the teen student to foster an insight and appreciation of the theater and the theatrical arts, and above all, theater education for teens in a fun and supportive atmosphere.

Youth have come from as far as Greenbelt, Laurel and Upper Marlboro on a regular basis.

In May 2009, a half dozen previous Teen Club members came to a Reunion to celebrate the upcoming 10 year anniversary. In response to the invitation, Katelyn

said, "I want to see everyone," and Jimmy replied, "This should be awesome." In addition to "clubbers," Ambassador Blango Ross, one of the founders of the Teen Club in 1999, came back from his church in Westminster to visit with old friends.

Teen Club is chaperoned and registration is required at the first visit. All visitors are asked to sign that they understood the simple rules of the Teen Club:

1. Be respectful of others.
2. No foul language, name calling, or weapons of any sort are allowed.
3. If you don't like something, try it anyway. Or, go to another room and find something you do like.
4. Clean up after yourself.

5. Permission is required to leave with someone other than with whom you came.

Most visitors quickly become members and receive a laminated Teen Club card. Prizes are often given to anyone bringing their card each month or for bringing friends with them. Membership is only \$10 for 10 months. Visitors pay \$2 per month. Refreshments are sold at minimal cost.

Teen Club begins again on Friday, September 4th from 7:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. and continues on the first Friday of each month until June. 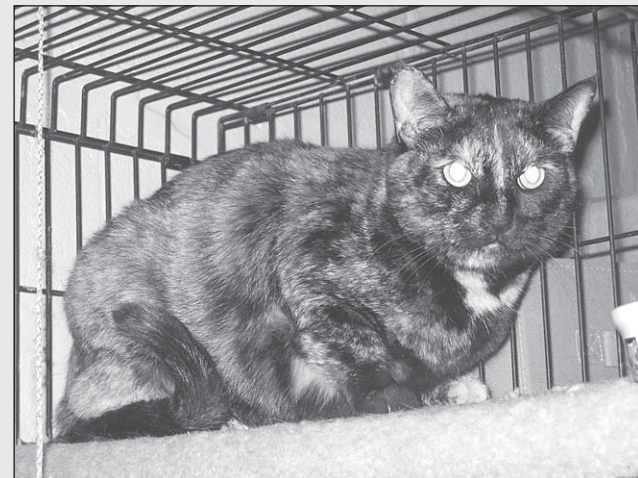

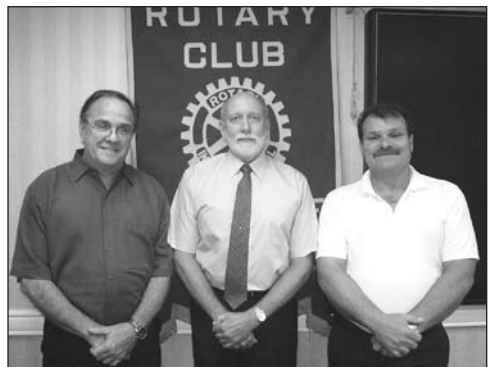

## Rosapepe's Report to Beltsville

### Protecting Fire Department Service in Beltsville and Calverton

Councilman Tom Dernoga, the Beltsville, Vansville and Hillandale Gardens/Knollwood Civic Associations have been working with the Beltsville Volunteer Fire Department and Prince George's County to protect our local fire service in the face of county budget cuts caused by the worldwide recession. They worked out an agreement this summer to move firefighters between the Beltsville and Calverton Fire stations so as to preserve the current level of service while reducing overtime costs. The county's new Fire Chief, Eugene Jones, who lives right here in Beltsville, met with dozens of local residents at the Beltsville Station on August 19 to explain the new arrangement and answer everyone's questions. Delegates Barbara Frush and Ben Barnes joined me at the meeting, expressing our support for the effort to preserve service and offering to work with the community to raise funds as needed for public safety. Delegate Josefine Peña-Melnyk supports these efforts, as well, but was unable to attend this meeting. Thanks to the Volunteer Fire Department, Chief Jones, and Councilman Dernoga for working out a practical way to protect Beltsville while saving taxpayers' money!

Too many people in our community and across the country have been victims of crooks preying on homeowners seeking mortgages or trying to prevent foreclosure. That's why, with the support of the state, Prince George's State's Attorney Glenn Ivey has set up a Mortgage Foreclosure Fraud Division to investigate and prosecute those who have allegedly defrauded or scammed homeowners and residents in the County. Here's what his office can do to help you if you think you have been victimized:

- bring criminal charges against individuals that had the intent to defraud;
- seek monetary restitution for victims;
- seek fines for breaking the laws;
- seek jail time for up to 15 years.

His office can also prosecute criminals that did business in the County even if the property is not in our County, and prosecute cases under the Protection of Homeowners in Foreclosure Act, Mortgage Fraud Statute, theft by deception, conspiracy and other counts.

To report such a crime, write a summary of why you think you were a victim of Mortgage or Foreclosure Fraud, including as much detail as possible. Then contact his office by sending your information to Lead Prosecutor April N. Richardson, Esq. at [anrichardson@co.pg.md.us](mailto:anrichardson@co.pg.md.us) or 301.952.3008; or Lead Investigator Ted Jones at [trjones@co.pg.md.us](mailto:trjones@co.pg.md.us) or 301.952.2874.

### Help Congressman Hoyer Protect Your Right to Health Insurance

As we all know President Obama has proposed health insurance reform to assure that all Americans have affordable access to the health insurance they need. In particular, his plan would stop insurance companies from denying coverage to people with pre-existing conditions or major health care needs, limit the amount that working families would have to pay for health insurance, and expand coverage to those who lose their jobs.

In August, opponents of expanded health insurance protection were very vocal and aggressive.
